Dean Beeby's book, *In A Crystal Land*, corrects this omission. It documents the experiences of fifteen Canadians, from Hugh Evans in 1899 to Gareth Woodin in 1986, who, as scientists, dog drivers, aviators, soldiers, and adventurers, were members of various English, American, and Norwegian Antarctic expeditions. The Antarctic map, provided on the endpapers, shows geographical features bearing testimony to their participation: Cape Evans, Mt Bursay, Cape Davies, Hollick-Kenyon Plateau, Mt Lymburner, Cheesman Is., Mt Taylor, Mt Innes-Taylor, and so on.

The deepest point on continental Earth has been identified in East Antarctica, under Denman Glacier. This ice-filled canyon reaches 3.5km (11,500ft) below sea level. Only in the ocean are the valleys deeper still. The discovery is illustrated in a new map of the White Continent that reveals the shape of the bedrock under the ice sheet in unprecedented detail. Its features will be critical to our understanding of how the polar south might change in the future. For comparison, the lowest exposed land on Earth, at the Dead Sea shore, is just 413m (1,355ft) below sea level. Here's a list of 5 great explorers to brave the harsh lands of the Arctic and Antarctica. Scott led two major expeditions to Antarctica in 1901 and 1910. Scott was selected as the leader of the National Antarctic Expedition 1901-04, which was sponsored by the Royal Geographic Society, the British Government and a London businessman, Llewellyn Longstaff. After a round of fundraising the expedition had a healthy balance of £90,000, more than enough to pay for a new ship, provisions, wages and other costs.
