It includes the seven-volume Seventh-day Adventist Bible Commentary, the two-volume Seventh-day Adventist Encyclopedia, as well as the single volumes Seventh-day Adventist Bible Dictionary, Seventh-day Adventist Bible Students' Source Book and Handbook of Seventh-day Adventist Theology. The series is published by the Seventh-day Adventist church-owned Review and Herald Publishing Association. I've not read a Smith & Helwys commentary before. Their structure shares a little bit with the Word series, having an intro to a chapter, a commentary section and then a "connections" section at the end of each section which explores how the passage might interact with modern faith, culture, or ideas. The best thing about this series is that there are sections marked out by brown text (and in a brown box) that follow different digressions that the author has considered worth note. On the balance I'd say this commentary stands a little on the 'liberal' side of the theological spectrum, but I appreciated that Odell delved into a wide range of different views, and was always keen to head back to the scriptures to argue for her particular read of a passage.
