The earliest almanac published for New England appeared in Cambridge, Massachusetts as early as 1639, by William Pierce. It was the second work printed in the English colonies of America altogether (the first being *The Oath of a Free-man*, printed earlier in the same year).[1] The earliest New England almanac of which an extant copy survives in the Library of Congress[2] was published by Zechariah Brigden in Cambridge in 1659.[3] Harvard College became the first center for. The most important early American almanacs were made from 1726-1775 by Nathaniel Ames of Dedham, Massachusetts. A few years later James Franklin began publishing the *Rhode-Island Almanack* beginning in 1728. "The United States almanac" 1776. Because early US almanacs contain much information about daily life, both by means of factual data and by implication, they are invaluable in the portrait they provide of health concerns; foods and their preparation; agricultural and veterinary practices; directions to and from geographical locations (not maps themselves); governmental officials; monetary information; schedules of Quaker meetings, circuit courts, freemen meetings; societies; chronologies; etc. The inclusion of poetry, epigrams, comic folk tales, essays, and the like in early almanacs reflects the charm and humor of the 18th-ce...
