Winner of the 2016 English 4-11 Picture Book Award and the 2016 Little Rebels Children's Book Award, this unique picture book features an enlightening story about individuality, courage and making a difference. Perfect for budding philosophers of all ages, the protagonist is Henry Finch, a loveable little bird who strives for greatness, gets it all a bit wrong, and then makes it right again in a very surprising way, becoming truly great in the process. Green Book has won the Oscar for best picture at the 91st Academy Awards. Based on a real-life road trip through the deep south in the early 1960s, Green Book's victory proved a considerable upset at the awards, after a night largely marked by predictability. After Alfonso Cuarón took the best director award for Roma, a victory in the main category "to add to its best foreign language film and best cinematography wins" had seemed a certainty. Named after the motoring handbook originally designed to help African American travellers avoid dangerous areas in the pre-civil rights US, Green Book is the story of black concert pianist Don Shirley and his Italian-American bodyguard/driver Tony Vallelonga, AKA Tony Lip.
