Welcome to the November 2018 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month. October is always a busy month with many books being published or announced, so we have an excellent roundup for you.

Readers interested in mammals can look forward to the paperback of Merlin Tuttle's [The Secret Lives of Bats: My Adventures with the World's Most Misunderstood Mammals](#), while he also contributes to Marianne Taylor's book [Bats: An Illustrated Guide to All Species](#), due in April from Ivy Press. For primatologists we have stock of Edition Chimaira's [Parasites of Apes: An Atlas of Coproscopic Diagnostics](#), whereas Cambridge University Press will publish [Primate Research and Conservation in the Anthropocene](#) in February. Bloomsbury, meanwhile, is releasing a second edition of [A Field Guide to the Carnivores of the World](#) in November.

Ornithologists and birdwatchers can choose from a wide range of titles this month. For UK birdwatchers we have the [Avon Bird Report 2017](#) and [Lancashire Bird Report 2017](#). Further afield, for European birdwatchers, we would like to highlight [Where to Watch Birds in France](#), due March from Pelagic Publishing, and [The Birds of Italy, Volume 1: Anatidae - Alcidae](#), due November from Edizioni Belvedere, which is the first of two volumes. Further afield still, we have the [Peterson Field Guide to Bird Sounds of Western North America](#), due April from Houghton Mifflin Harcourt, and [North American Ducks, Geese and Swans: Identification Guide](#) from Hancock House Publishers which is available now. Lastly, Faber & Faber will publish the paperback of Miriam Darlington's [Owl Sense](#) in January.

For entomologists, too, we have diverse titles on offer this month. The Amateur Entomologists' Society has just rereleased [A Coleopterist's Handbook](#) in paperback, the Royal Entomological Society has just published [RES Handbook, Volume 7, Part 12: Ichneumonid Wasps \(Hymenoptera: Ichneumonidae\): Their Classification and Biology](#), and NatureBureau has announced an [Atlas of Britain and Ireland's Larger Moths](#) for April. We have just received stock of [A Taxonomic Guide to the Stick Insects of Sumatra, Volume 1](#), published by Natural History Publications Borneo. KNNV in the Netherlands is co-publishing the bilingual book [Les Larves de Libellules de Paul-André Robert: L'Oeuvre d'une Vie / Die Libellenlarven von Paul-André Robert: Sein Lebenswerk](#) in November. And then there is the paperback of Thor Hanson's [Buzz: The Nature and Necessity of Bees](#) in April from Icon Books.

There are three titles of interest to herpetologists this month. Edition Chimaira has just released [Threatened Newts and Salamanders of the World, Volume 2](#) and [The Genus Triturus: History, Biology, Systematics, Captive Breeding](#), while Academic Press will publish [Amphibians of North Africa](#) in April.

Botanists this month can choose from field guides, such as second editions of John Beaufoy's [A Naturalist's Guide to the Wild Flowers of Britain and Northern Europe](#) and [A Naturalist's Guide to the Trees of Britain and Northern Europe](#), both due April, and Mifa Publication's [The National Botanical Garden of Seychelles](#), now in stock. The privately published [Smut and Allied Fungi of Wales: A Guide, Red Data List and Census Catalogue](#) combines several types of book into one and is also in stock now. Michael Joseph will publish a nice piece of nature writing in March in the form of [Moss: A Magical Tour of the Hidden Wonders of Moss](#).

There are a large number of books on issues surrounding conservation. For professionals we can offer [Farming, Food and Nature: Respecting Animals, People and the Environment](#) from Earthscan, [Origins of Biodiversity: An Introduction to Macroevolution and Macroecology](#), due April from Oxford University Press, [Human-Wildlife Interactions: Turning Conflict into Coexistence](#), due April from Cambridge University Press, and [Wildlife and Wind Farms, Conflicts and Solutions, Volume 3: Offshore: Potential Effects](#), due January from Pelagic Publishing. For general readers there are books on the horizon such as Jeremy Purseglove's [Working with Nature: Saving and Using the World's Wild Places](#), due April from Profile Books, the essay collection [Rewilding](#), due April from Harper Collins, and [There Is No Plan\[et\] B: A Handbook for the Make or Break Years](#), due February from Cambridge University Press. Following in the footsteps of her last book [The Bumblebee Flies Anyway](#), Kate Bradbury is writing the practical [Wildlife Gardening: For Everyone and Everything](#), due April from Bloomsbury. Finally, we have just received stock of [Scotland: A Rewilding Journey](#), published by Scotland - The Big Picture.

For readers interested in evolutionary biology and palaeontology we have a range of interesting titles coming up. Oxford University Press will publish the paperback of [Who We Are and How We Got Here: Ancient DNA and the New Science of the Human Past](#) in February. Yale University Press will publish [Nature's Giants: The Biology and Evolution of the World's Largest Lifeforms](#) in April. More academically inclined titles are [What Species Mean: A User's Guide to the Units of Biodiversity](#), due November from Productivity Press, and [Rates of Evolution: A Quantitative Synthesis](#), due April from Cambridge University Press. Then there is [A Guide to Fossil Collecting on the West Dorset Coast](#), due December from Siri Scientific Press, and the paperback of [The Walking Whales: From Land to Water in Eight Million Years](#) due April from the University of California Press.

For those who want to curl up in a chair with a good book, we have some good nature writing and other books for leisure reading. Harper Collins will publish the paperback of [Curlew Moon](#), while Wildfire will publish [The Deep: The Secret Life of Our Oceans](#), both due April. Rob Dunn is writing the rather amusing sounding [Never Home Alone: From Microbes to Millipedes, Camel Crickets, and Honeybees, the Natural History of Where We Live](#), due November from Basic Books. Lastly, Princeton will publish the paperback of the fascinating [The Fate of Rome: Climate, Disease, & the End of an Empire](#) in April.

If you would rather go outdoors, we have [The Essential Guide to Rockpooling](#), due April from Wild Nature Press. For safari-goers we have [Nature Unpacked: The Traveller's Ultimate Bush Guide to Southern Africa](#), due March from Briza Publications, and [Stuarts' Field Guide to Game and Nature Reserves of East Africa](#), due December from Random House Struik.
