Programming with infinite lists open up a new way of writing programs, where you give rules for generating a sequence rather than building it by hand – often leading to simpler code. Since data types are lazy and support self references, you can produce a list dynamically by defining it as a function of its successors. The simplest example of this is the sequence of natural numbers (ie.
