He is best known as the author of the children's book *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland* (1865) and its sequel *Through the Looking-Glass* (1871)—two of the most popular works of fiction in the English language. When and where was Lewis Carroll born? Charles Lutwidge Dodgson—better known by his pen name, Lewis Carroll—was born on January 27, 1832, in Daresbury, Cheshire, England. He was the eldest son and third child of the Rev. Charles Dodgson and Frances Jane Lutwidge. Charles from the first showed a great aptitude for inventing games to amuse them.
