Accepting the administrative state as a permanent feature of the political landscape means accepting that, if environmental problems are to be solved, they must be solved in major part administratively—through more, different, somehow better administration. This is the point of departure for a majority of environmental reformers and policy analysts, who worry little about the fundamental structure of their political world. Conflicts between scientific expertise and politics have been part of environmental struggles from their beginning in the late 1960s. What, then, is wrong with the administrative state when it comes to environmental protection? At least three shortcomings may be identified. First, in terms of the basic criterion of environmental quality, administration is less than it once was.
