He has written widely on the Romantic Period and is the editor of Byron's 'Complete Poetical Works' in seven volumes and of the one-volume Oxford Authors 'Byron'. Other publications include 'The Romantic Ideology. A Critical Investigation' (1983), 'Social Values and Poetic Acts' (1987), and 'Towards a Literature of Knowledge' (1989). But we should ask, as apparently the Oxford editors haven't, why in any case the period in question should have an anthology devoted to it.Â It is by James Montgomery (1771-1854), who indeed figures in the New Oxford Book, as the author of 26 heroic couplets from an unread, and in bulk unreadable, poem, 'The Bramin'. Jerome McGann, given a choice, will always pass over a poem that has been accepted into the popular consciousness in favour of one not known nor available outside scholarly libraries.
